#### <u> ITINERARY:</u>



Day 01: Arrive in Delhi

Meals: N/A

Accommodation: 5\* hotel in Delhi

You will take flight from hometown to Delhi and arrive in the evening. From Airport, you will be picked up and proceed to the hotel. Check in the hotel and take some rest.

Day 02: Delhi Sightseeing

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: 5\* hotel in Delhi

Post breakfast, visit Qutub Minar which a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the tallest (250 ft) building in the world made of bricks.

Take a tour to famous Lotus Temple. It is one of the world's most beautiful religious buildings and known for its flower-like architecture and marvelous ambiance.

Explore the historic story of Humayun's Tomb. It is the tomb of the Mughal Emperor Humayun which was commissioned by Humayun's first wife and chief consort, Empress Bega Begum in 1558

Qutub Minar, Lotus Temple, Humayun's Tomb Opening Time 8:30/9:00 AM – 5:00/ 5:30 PM. (Exact time may vary for summer/winter months and subject to Govt rule).

In the afternoon, you may go for a drive towards Rashtrapati Bhavan, India Gate, and Parliament House. You may pay tribute to Amar Jawan Jyoti - the eternal flame to remind the nation of soldiers who laid down their lives in the Indo-Pakistan War of December 1971.

Later visit the Jama masjid mosque and proceed to Chandani Chowk to enjoy some shopping and having the famous chat at local stalls. Return to the hotel, enjoy your dinner and take good rest.

Day 03: Delhi Sightseeing

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: 5\* Hotel in Delhi

After breakfast, proceed for Delhi sightseeing.

Start your tour to Akshardham, hailed as an eternal place of devotion, purity, and peace. Swaminarayan Akshardham at New Delhi is a Mandir – an abode of God, a Hindu house of

worship, and a spiritual and cultural campus with white marble architecture dedicated to devotion, learning, and harmony.

Akshardham Opening time: 9:30 AM – 6:30 PM (exact time may vary for summer/winter months and subject to Govt rules). Akshardham is closed on Monday. Akshardham has an evening light and sound laser show, which happens around 6:30/7:30 PM, depending on sunset and show time.

(Please Note: You can't take any Electronic Items (Mobiles, Camera, Pen Drives, Hands-Free etc.) All Bags, Purses (Shoulder Strap / Hanging), outside Food & Drinks, Toys, Tobacco & Alcohol Products, and All Personal Belongings inside the temple premises. You can keep your things at the Cloakroom Facilities Available near Parking lot, or you can leave all things in your vehicle.

In the afternoon, visit Lal Quila (Red Fort), which was the main residence of the emperors of the Mughal dynasty. It was built by Shah Jahan in the mid-17th century and remains a major tourist attraction.

Lal Quila opening time: 9:30 AM – 4:30 PM (Closed on Monday). PM (exact time may vary for summer/winter months and subject to Govt rule) Lal Quila light and sound show timings are 7.30 PM to 8.30 PM for Hindi show. For show in English language, the timings are from 9 PM to 10 PM.

Later visit Lodhi Garden which is a captivating park, located in the New Delhi. It presents an impressive blend of lush greenery and majestic architectures which belong to 15th and 16th century.

Lodhi Garden opening and closing time: 6:00 AM – 08:00 PM (Closed on Monday). PM (exact time may vary for summer/winter months and subject to Govt rule)

Spend your evening visiting Hauz khas village and enjoy your dinner. Later return to the hotel and take some rest.

Day 04: Agra sightseeing (240 KM/ 4 Hours)

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: 5\* Hotel at Agra

Post breakfast, check out from hotel with luggage and proceed to Agra. Visit Agra Fort, World Heritage Site by UNESCO. This huge edifice is an enormous, fortified city that was once a residential place of the great Mughal emperors. It contains a labyrinth of buildings and giant underground sections. The sixth and the last effective Mughal emperor captivated his father, Shah Jahan in this fort only. Visit Diwan-i-Aam (Hall of Public Audience), Diwan-i-Khas (Hall of Private Audience), Khas Mahal, Shah Jahan Mahal, Anguri Bagh.

Check in to hotel (Check-in time 2:00 PM) and in afternoon go to Fatehpur Sikri (the City of Victory) is a UNESCO heritage site, built during the second half of the 16th century by the 3 Emperor Akbar. It was the capital of the Mughal Empire for only some 10 years. The complex of monuments and temples, all in a uniform architectural style, includes one of the largest mosques in India, the Jama Masjid. Buland Darwaza gate is the entrance to Jama Masjid mosque. Nearby is the marble Tomb of Salim Chishti and Diwan-E-Kha's hall having a carved central pillar.

Agra Fort, Fatehpur Sikri and Taj Mahal – Open from 6:00 AM – 6:00/6:30 PM (exact time may vary for summer/winter months and subject to Govt rule). Taj Mahal may be closed partially on Friday. Fatehpur Sikri Museum/Mosque may be closed on Friday.

Later in the evening, check in to hotel in Agra and have your dinner.

Day O5: Agra Sightseeing and Return to Delhi

Meals: Breakfast

Accommodation: NA

Post breakfast, check out from hotel with luggage and visit Taj Mahal. Emperor Shah Jahan built the structure as a monument and tomb to his favorite wife, Mumtaz Mahal, a Persian princess. It was the first Mughal building erected entirely using marble.

(Please Note: Outside vehicle will not go till the entrance gate of Taj Mahal, you need to take battery operator vehicle (if available) from the gate where vehicle will drop you or you can go by walk. Approx 1-1.5KM)
